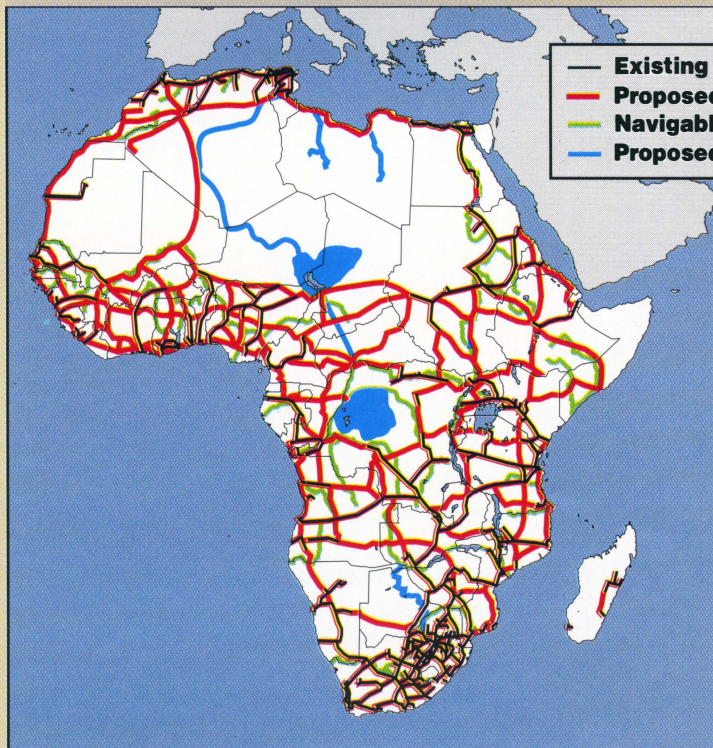


## MAP 19 Africa, rivers and proposed waterways



*Existing rivers, and proposed new lakes and waterways. Daming part of the Zaire (Congo) River, the second largest river in volume in the world, would create a Central African lake. In the sub-Sahara region, Lake Chad must be expanded by diverting north some of the flow of the Ubangi River. Lake Chad could give rise to a trans-Sahara canal to the Mediterranean.*

## MAP 20 Africa, rail and waterway development



*The transcontinental rail and priority water projects show the vast potential for this huge continent. Finishing the Jonglei Canal on the White Nile in southern Sudan could add over 5% to the flow of the Nile. All such projects, combined with nuclear-powered development complexes, would be the basis for billions more people.*
